221 Families Served in Minnesota during FY17

Housing Production – April 2018

Through volunteer labor, homeowner “sweat equity,” and donations of money and materials, Minnesota’s local Habitat offices build, rehabilitate, and repair homes. In FY17, more than 200 families partnered with Habitat in Minnesota on varying types of projects to build or improve their homes. The number and type of projects vary based on size, capacity, strategic planning, and regional factors for each local Habitat office.

Owner-Occupied Repairs:

Homeowners apply to their local Habitat office to receive necessary repairs to their home. These repairs can range from exterior painting and carpentry repairs to safety and accessibility modifications.

Rehabilitated Homes:

Homes are acquired by or donated to a Habitat affiliate, then reconstructed or renovated and sold to a Habitat homeowner.

New Construction:

From groundbreaking to final touches, Habitat staff, volunteers, and future homeowners work together to construct decent, affordable homes.

How does Habitat for Humanity in Minnesota partner with families?

Recycled Homes:

Homes are built and sold by Habitat, then reacquired by an affiliate. The home is later resold to a new Habitat homeowner.

22 of 31 Minnesota affiliates completed at least one new, recycle, or rehab construction project in FY17 in Minnesota.

9 of 31 Minnesota affiliates completed at least one repair project in FY17 in Minnesota.

Affiliates have **tithed more than \$2 million** to support homebuilding around the world.

Affiliates have **repaired more than 1,000 homes** in Minnesota.
