Useful Facts and Figures— Data for Affiliates

Tithe – May 2020

In FY19, US affiliates tithed over \$14.6 million to countries around the globe! Tithe represents a percentage of undesignated revenue from each affiliate; this revenue supports Habitat for Humanity’s international work with the “vision that requires that every person everywhere has safe and secure housing.”* Minnesota affiliates supported this effort with a total tithe of over \$558,000 in FY19, supporting countries all over the world.

FY19 National Statistics

• \$14.6 million tithed

- 3,244 families served abroad through US tithe
- \$3,400 median tithe (higher than FY18)
- \$14,000 average tithe (higher than FY18)

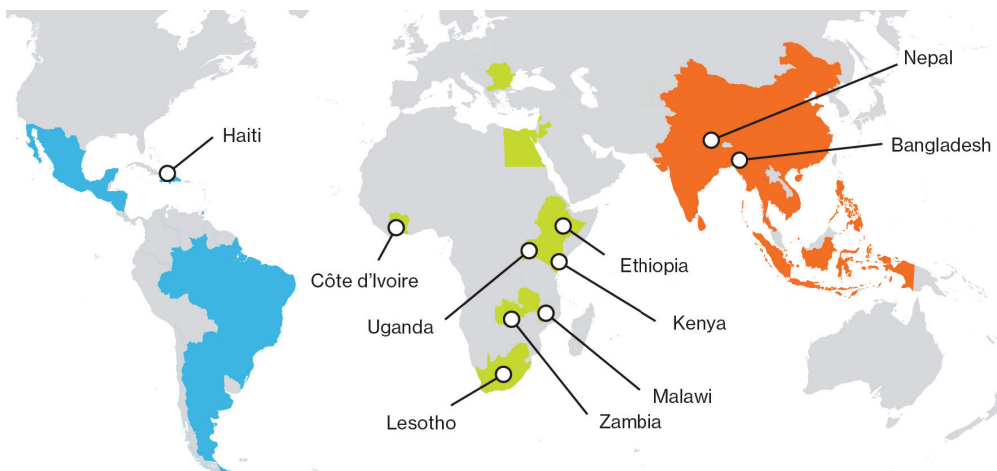
Over \$286.6 million has been tithed by US affiliates to date, serving more than 87,400 families!

FY19 Minnesota Statistics

\$558,346 tithed in FY19 by Habitat Minnesota and the 28 Minnesota affiliates.

To date, over \$9.6 million has been tithed by Minnesota, ensuring that thousands of families around the world have a decent place to live.

Four Minnesota affiliates—Douglas County, Itasca County, North St. Louis County, & Twin Cities Habitat—made the top ten tithers list, based on their relative size, in FY19.
